This letter is an acknowledgement of your entry into the **2019 SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH**. Please show this letter to your parents to read and ask them to sign the yellow Science Talent Search Face Sheet (Insert 5).

You should keep **photocopies and/or electronic copies** of your work, as all care will be taken with entries but no responsibility will be accepted for lost or damaged work.

YOUR entry must be carefully packaged with a correctly completed yellow face sheet (and Project identification sticky label) glued on the outside. A **separate copy of the signed form** must be attached with your project which may be collected. If there is more than one package, **each** package must be labelled with a photocopied face sheet. All equipment or loose items should be packed into a solid carton. Small pieces of entries can be lost if entries are not packaged carefully. Research & Creative Writing entries will be submitted electronically. In term 4, results will be sent to schools, and you will be notified by your teacher.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES *(usually arranged by your school)*

METROPOLITAN

Creative Writing and **Experimental Research** entries must be submitted in **electronic format**. If it is not in electronic form, you may photograph or scan your work which can be submitted **by your teacher** to the online submission portal by **21 July**. These dates **MUST** be observed, as entries cannot be accepted after 21 July to be processed for judging.

Note: *Posters, Videos, Photographs, Models, Inventions, Games, Computers & Class Projects **MUST** be taken to the **SPECIAL JUDGING VENUES** (see back of this sheet) on Saturday 3 August.*

COUNTRY

Entries in ALL SECTIONS must be submitted **electronically by your teacher** to STS by **21 July**. If you are going to attend a special Judging Day venue, please advise STS via your teacher by 17th July.

Please Note: *Parents are not permitted to sit with their child during the judging process at Special Judging Day venues. Parent waiting areas will be available.*

Securely pack your work in a solid carton no larger than 0.5m x 0.5m x 0.5m.

DO NOT send or bring live specimens.

NOTE: Judging day date, times and Venue location details should be on the flip side of this letter. If not, ask your teacher for the Special Judging Day information sheet.
